## PREOPERATIVELY (BEFORE SURGERY)

- 1. Must be on our skin care program for 4 to 6 weeks: Combination of Retin-A and hydroquinone.
- 2. Start antiviral medication, Valtrex, two days prior to laser.

## POSTOPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR LASER SKIN RESURFACING

- 1. Maintain Silicone mask until next office visit in 3 or 4 days. If the mask peels away from your face (or chin), you can trim it away with scissors and apply CU-3 cream to the exposed areas of skin.
- 2. Apply the recommended cream or moisturizer to any exposed skin where the mask comes off to keep your face lubricated.
